Collaborations

■ This section will highlight collaborations and projects that are showing true essence of global psychology, cross-cultural / national collaborations, and projects occurring outside of the USA. Additionally, this section will serve as a call from Members to develop collaborations. Submissions should be 500 words max. Submissions that are co-written with an international collaborator (does not need to be a Division 52 member) will be prioritized. Additionally, IPB is looking to enhance readership through publishing pieces in both English and the language of the collaborating culture/nation, these submissions will also receive priority.

Pilot Study Corner

This section will highlight current international and global psychology pilot studies that are either underway or have been completed. The aim of this corner is to highlight pilot studies and promising projects and provide Members an opportunity to put a call out to other Members and readers to develop research collaborations to expand upon the pilot study or promising project, or to launch a research initiative. Submissions should be 500 words max. Submissions that are co-written with an international collaborator (does not need to be a Division 52 member) will be prioritized. Additionally, IPB is looking to

enhance readership through publishing pieces in both English and the language of the collaborating culture/nation, these submissions will also receive priority.
