Inter-American Psychological Society (IPS) - (Sociedad Interamericana de Psicología in Spanish)

The Inter-American Psychological Society (IPS) was founded in 1951 and brings together psychology professionals from North, Central, and South America and the Caribbean. The IPS has the following objectives:

Objectives of the Inter-American Psychological Society (IPS)

- To provide means of direct communication between psychologists and scientists in related areas in North, Central, and South America and the Caribbean, and to promote the development of behavioral sciences in the Western Hemisphere.
- To contribute to international understanding through a broader understanding of cultural differences and encounters beyond national boundaries.
- To help promote research and academic and professional exchange among the nations of the Americas.

The official languages of the IPS are Spanish, English, Portuguese, and French. The IPS publishes *la Revista Interamericana de Psicología* and a newsletter. Active membership receives both publications electronically. The Society has a network of National Representatives and Country Delegates in the different regions of the Americas, which serves as a liaison with our Central Office. IPS members have formed different Working Groups in different areas of psychology with the aim of exchanging information and generating common projects.

Every two years, the Inter-American Congress of Psychology is held in order to promote the exchange of information and ideas on psychology and related disciplines. This activity takes place in different countries of the American continent every odd year.

Fortieth Inter-American Congress of Psychology of the Inter-American Society of Psychology (CIP 2025)

From July 14 to 18, 2025, the Inter-American Congress of Psychology (CIP 2025) will be held in San Juan, Puerto Rico. The CIP 2025 is being held in the context of the thirtieth anniversary of the celebration of the first IAPA Congress in Puerto Rico, held in 1995, and on the fortieth anniversary of the Inter-American Congresses. Returning to Puerto Rico, the home country of the IPS Central Office and a bridge for the exchange of psychological knowledge from the Americas and the

Caribbean, will have great significance for the participating countries and psychologists.

Themes

The 40th Inter-American Congress of Psychology (CIP 2025) with the theme, ONE PSYCHOLOGY FOR ALL THE AMERICAS, seeks to disseminate, discuss, and advance the production of knowledge and practices developed in the regions that make up the IPS. The main objective of CIP 2025 is to foster dialogue between local, regional, international, and global perspectives to promote a better understanding of the challenges and opportunities facing psychology as a science and profession today.

The following six (6) thematic tracks will organize the activities of the Congress:

1. Social and disciplinary transformations
2. Decolonizing Our Psychology for a Collective Liberation
3. Inter and transdisciplinarity: collaboration and connection
4. Human mobility, migration and transnationality
5. Indigenous peoples and psychology: challenges and contributions
6. Climate change, psychosocial impact and human rights

The tracks synthesize themes of relevance and validity in current historical and socio-cultural contexts and are wide-ranging. Today its dimensions are worked on from all areas of psychology that include clinical,

educational, social community, political, labor, neuropsychology and human development, among many others.

We encourage proposals for contributions to the Congress program that show how the various specialties of the discipline have approached the study of and work with phenomena and processes related to the aforementioned tracks in their particular contexts.

Modalities for submission of papers

International Symposium (90 minutes)

Composed of several (3-5) presentations of original works related to a project, focus or theme from two (2) or more countries/continents.

Panels (60 minutes)

Composed of several (3-4) individual interventions that will develop a specific theme. Its members will be from the same country.

Discussion/Round Table (60 minutes)

This interactive format will facilitate in-depth dialogues on a topic.

Thematic Sessions (90 minutes)

It consists of individual oral presentation proposals that will present the advances and/or results of scientific productions, professional practices, and academic

works. These free works will be grouped by the scientific committee based on thematic similarity.

Digital Posters

It consists of a graphic and summarized presentation of scientific research in digital form. The posters will be presented in digital format (PDF and short video) during the congress.

Book Presentation (60 minutes)

It consists of the presentation by authors of their most recent books in psychology or related sciences. The books to be submitted must have been published between 2020 and 2025, and have an ISBN registration.

Workshops (180 minutes)

It consists of a practical and participatory experience focusing on the development or strengthening of skills. The workshops will be able to link research and intervention techniques that participants can implement once they return to their study or work scenarios.

Visual Exhibition/Art (60 minutes)

In this format, one or more audiovisual/artistic aspects (e.g. photo exposure) or visual aspects (e.g. development of a documentary as a means of intervention) are used as the main exhibition mechanism.

Dialogue spaces (60 minutes)

CIP 2025 will have an assigned room each day to promote dialogues that arise sponta-

neously after presentations, meetings, or other activities of the Congress. The objective is that the participants can continue their exchanges to clarify conceptual issues, develop joint intervention or research projects, manage academic exchanges, among other possibilities.

Congress Venue

The Congress will be held at the Sheraton Hotel, in the Convention District, in the city of San Juan, capital of Puerto Rico.

The Convention District has a dozen restaurants and entertainment venues. Very close to the District is located the Caribe Hilton Hotel, which served as the venue for the 1995 Congress. The Sheraton Hotel has 11 conference rooms of various sizes for academic and professional activities, a central space or ballroom with space for 1,500 people and 400 rooms.

The city of San Juan, capital of Puerto Rico, is one of the most popular tourist destinations for its vibrant atmosphere full of history, culture and tradition. In addition, it has an architectural mix between its colonial structures and modern infrastructure.

Visas

The Organizing Committee may write a general invitation letter to the Congress to individuals who need to apply for a visa to attend the Congress (i.e., visa to enter U.S. territory). The Puerto Rico Department of State has indicated that, if you have any difficulty, either because the visa interview is scheduled for a date very close to Congress or because it is denied, you should contact us to request that the Department issue a communication establishing the importance of your participation in the event. While the State Department's submission of the communication is not a guarantee that you will be granted a visa, it is a

step that could facilitate the process.

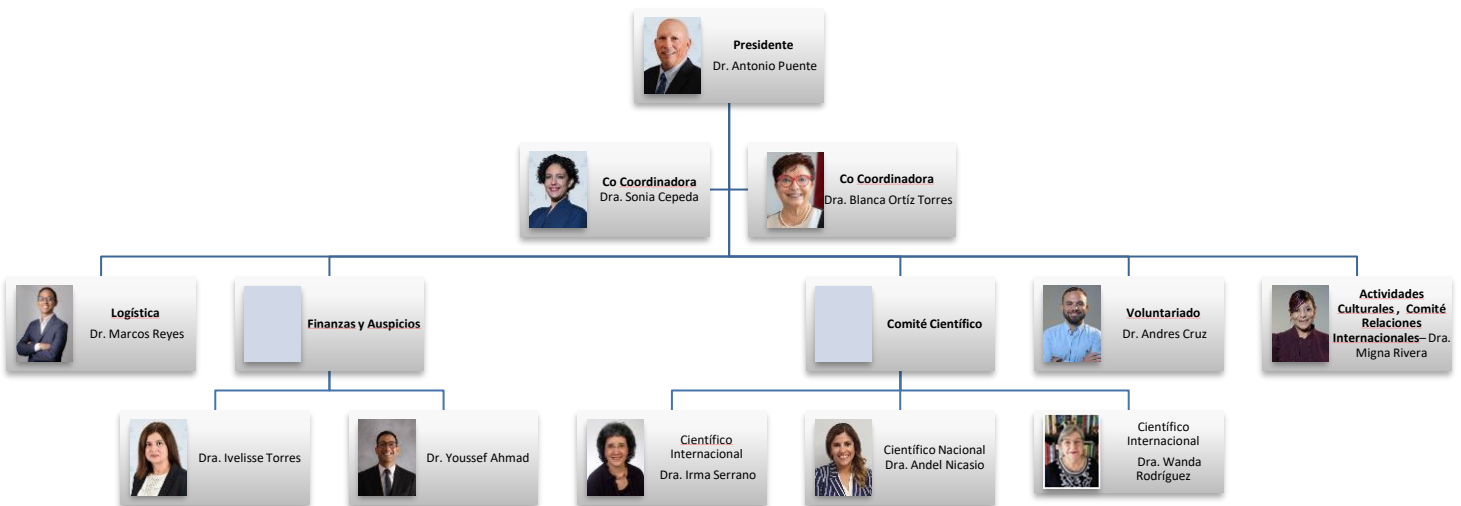
Transportation

In San Juan, Puerto Rico, there are several transportation options available to its visitors. Luis Muñoz Marín International Airport is located at a distance of 10.9 km from the congress venue. From the airport you can access private taxi transportation, as well as public transportation to the hotel hosting the congress and neighboring areas. The approximate travel time by car is 15 minutes. In addition to the taxi transportation available throughout the city, participants will be able to make use of the Uber transportation application. At the airport, people

can also rent a car from one of the many car rental agencies that are available there. People staying in Old San Juan will be able to use the Trolley that, for free, travels through different tourist spots in the city. For the cultural and social activities of the congress that will be held outside the host hotel, transportation will be provided to facilitate the tour between the locations. This is a short tour of about 15 minutes.
